

WE ARE WORKING TO PROTECT OUR BIRDS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC FROM DISEASE AND INJURY, AND HAVE INSTIGATED BIOSECURITY MEASURES AT THIS EVENT

Our biosecurity measures include:

- **Physical barriers between public and birds.**
- **Signage warning of biosecurity measures.**
- **General public not allowed to handle/touch any bird except under strict supervision.**
- **Any person allowed to touch a bird can only do so while wearing protective glove.**
- **All such persons are given a hand wipe immediately after the handling.**
- **All faecal material, casts etc are collected and properly disposed of at end of each day and at the end of the event.**
- **All equipment is cleansed and disinfected before and after the event.**
- **All birds are checked on a regular basis by a veterinary surgeon.**
- **Staff wash hands thoroughly before leaving the bird area.**
